What is involved?

-Clean up Communion Cups and bread trays after each service. Return items to the kitchen closet.

When does it happen?

-We can be flexible! Choose the dates you would like to prepare Communion. Suggested times might be once a month, once a quarter, only in the summer, etc.

All items needed to prepare Communion are kept in the church kitchen.

Ministry Scope: Our main mission is to help watch for problems around the church campus. We also help direct visitors and others to different locations around the Church campus; we help walk the halls of the building and also the parking lot. If there is a problem you would contact the Team Lead and they will determine additional actions that are needed. We are friendly and helpful.

Ministry Involvement Opportunities: Anyone 18 yrs. and older, no special training is needed; we will teach you how we operate. Team members normally work one (1) Sunday a month during both services. We also occasionally ask for help during special events; such as: Christmas Candle light services, Easter, Church Luncheons, Children's events or other special times. Some members may also work during Wednesday night services. Normally serving occurs on the Church campus, but on rare occasions when an event is off site, we maybe asked to be there.



Medical Team

Ministry Scope: We would ask that you be available to help members and visitors to Southwest if they should have an issue while at Church. We have an AED, stocked First Aid Bag and Oxygen located on the Church Campus.

Ministry Involvement Opportunities: Anyone 17 yrs. and older with at least a current First Aid and CPR certification. We would also like to have folks that are EMT's, Paramedics, Nurses, PA's, NP's, Doctors or other allied Health Professionals.

All we ask is that when you are at Church, there is a sign-up Board located with the medical equipment. Just put your name on the board along with your cell number; when you leave just erase your name so we know you are no longer available that day. If there is a problem someone from the Security Team will contact or locate you for your help. On occasion we may have you carry a radio; we have ear pieces so that you can listen to it and not disturb others or the service. Normally serving is limited to the Church campus; but on rare occasions when an event is off site, we may be asked to be there.
